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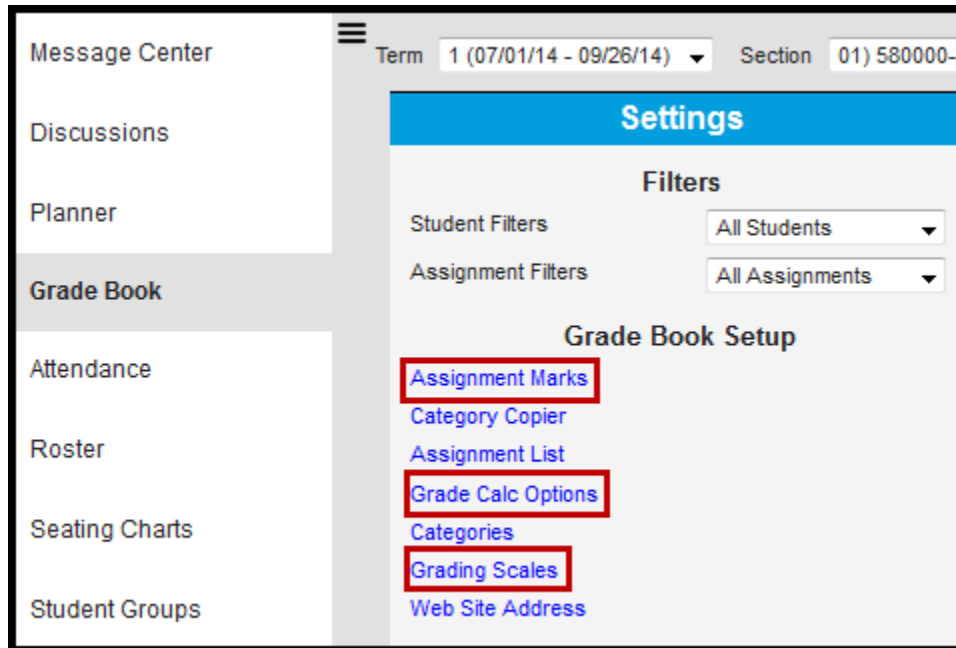
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Scoring Setup

Establishing scoring rules and preferences is the first step of grading set up. This scoring setup is done in the **Settings** portion of the **Grade Book**.



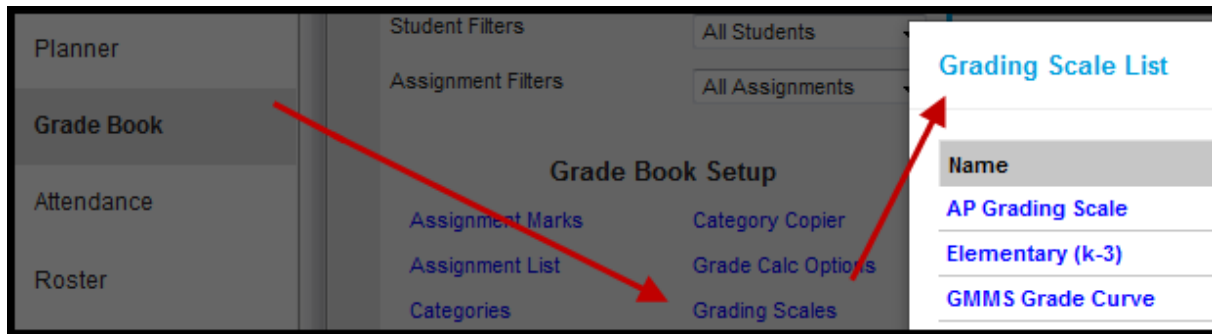
Tools for Grade Book Setup

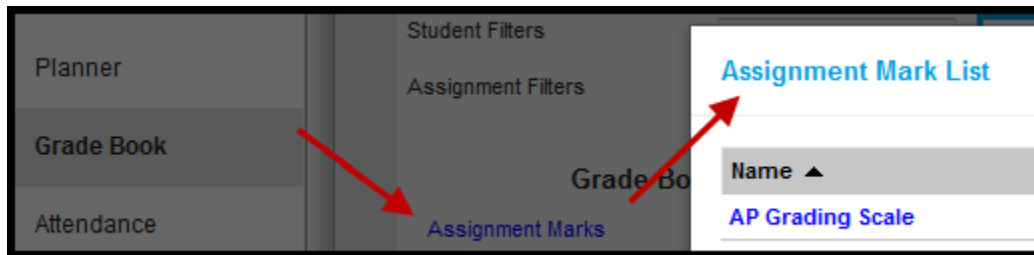
If you want to use [Grading Scales](#) other than those provided by your district, create them in the Grading Scales tool.

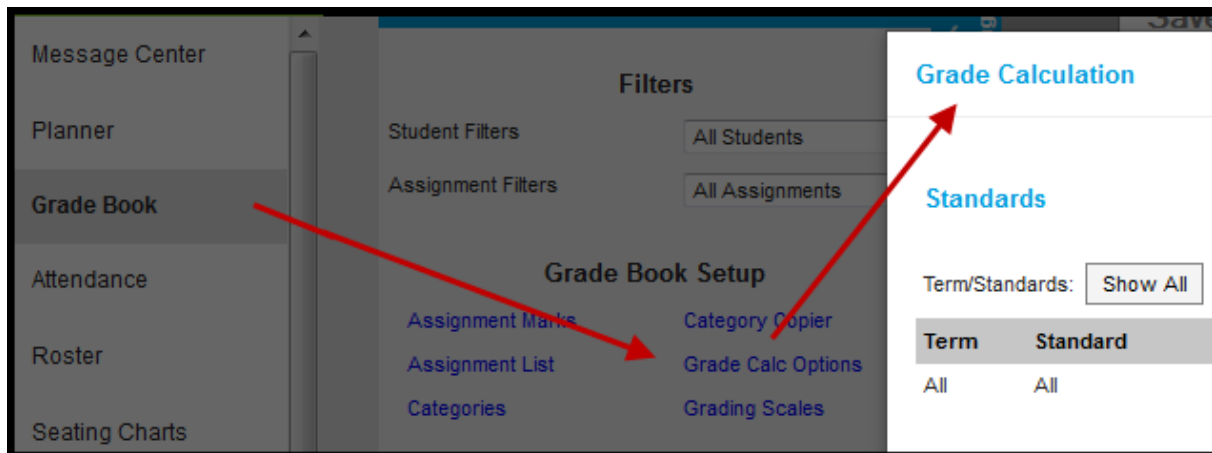
